2022 Virtual Super Quiz[™] Format and Guidelines

The virtual Super Quiz virtual will use the same format as the objective testing on the <u>http://usadtest.com</u> site. The proctor will give each student their Super Quiz Test Activation Key according to their GPA category.

All varsity students will have the same varsity Super Quiz test key, all scholastic students will have the same scholastic Super Quiz test key, and all honor students will have the same honor Super Quiz test key

Each Super Quiz test will have a total of 18 multiple-choice questions with five possible answer choices. The questions and subjects are randomized with the exception of the two mathematics questions, which will be the final two questions. Students will have 10 minutes to complete their Super Quiz test.

The proctor will activate the varsity Super Quiz test first and wait for the 10-minute timer to end the test. The proctor will activate the scholastic Super Quiz second and wait for the 10-minute timer to end the test. The proctor will activate the honor Super Quiz third and wait for the 10-minute timer to end the test.

Questions are worth one point each for a total of 18 points, per team, per round. The Super Quiz team awards will be presented at the awards ceremony on Saturday. The perfect score per series would be 18 points x 3 rounds = 54 points.

The Super Quiz is a standalone event and scores will NOT be added to individual or team scores.

GUIDELINES:

- Each team will have between 6 to 9 participants including:
- 2 3 honor (3.80 4.00 GPA),
- 2 3 scholastic (3.20 3.799 GPA), and
- 2 3 varsity (0.00 3.199 GPA) decathletes.
- Students will NOT be able to deliberate with each other during the Super Quiz virtual testing event.
- Students are NOT permitted to bring books, notes, purses, backpacks, coats, hats, cell phones, electronic devices or any other items into the testing room, except for one acceptable calculator for the mathematics questions.
- Students should remain quietly at their computer until all rounds of Super Quiz testing are complete.
- Each decathlete has a 4 digit identification number. The School ID is the first 2 digits and the second two digits identify the category (honor = 01, 02, 03; scholastic = 04, 05, 06; and varsity = 07, 08, 09).
