Essay and art events

The USAD essay and art events will be held on March 31 at 12:30 p.m. with essay first, followed immediately by art. Your team must participate in a practice session between

March 24, 12:30 p.m. and March 30, 5 p.m., so USAD can confirm all teams/students will be able to access the testing site on competition day. All students and proctors must test their usernames and passwords on these days, even if your team has participated in a USAD national competition in the past. **All students MUST participate in the essay and art testing on March 31. Student(s) who do not participate will not be eligible to participate in the 2022 USAD National competition.** Please refer to the Nationals Online Technical Information, located on the 2022 USAD Nationals webpage, for more details.

Team ID numbers will be assigned and posted on the 2022 USAD Nationals webpage in early April after all state competitions have been completed.
