Nationals registration information

All forms MUST be emailed (nationals@usad.org) and/or postmarked by March 17. Please make sure all forms are typed (preferred) or printed legibly. Names of students and teams will appear on all documentation as they appear on the online team roster form. No name corrections will be made after March 20.

Coaches, teams and state directors: please comply with the deadline dates specified for submission of your team registration(s) and roster(s). If your competition is too close to the March 17 deadline for forms to be received on time, please email your forms to nationals@usad.org and indicate the originals have been placed in the mail.

Registration and team identification – Coaches will be emailed ID badges for all students participating in Nationals prior to the competition. These badges will include students' names, competition ID number, and scheduled speech and interview times. Students must have their ID badges as well as an official photo ID (school ID, driver's license, passport, etc.) with them when they participate in the speech and interview events, so the judges may verify their identity.

Thursday, March 31

Essay and art events

The USAD essay and art events will be held on March 31 at 12:30 p.m. with essay first, followed immediately by art. Your team must participate in a practice session between March 24, 12:30 p.m. and March 30, 5 p.m., so USAD can confirm all teams/students will be able to access the testing site on competition day. All students and proctors must test their usernames and passwords on these days, even if your team has participated in a USAD national competition in the past. All students MUST participate in the essay and art testing on March 31. Student(s) who do not participate will not be eligible to participate in the 2022 USAD Nationals competition. Please refer to the Nationals Online Technical Information, located on the 2022 USAD Nationals webpage, for more details.

Most valuable team member (MVTM)

After students have completed the online essay and art tests, they will be prompted to complete a rubric to register their vote for the Most Valuable Team Member on their team. Each member of the official team is eligible to vote. Votes will remain anonymous, and the rubrics will be scored by the computer. A sample of the rubric will be posted on the 2022 USAD Nationals webpage.

Tuesday, April 19

Mandatory coach and international meeting – **6**–**7 p.m.** (Zoom link will be emailed to coaches)

There will be a mandatory meeting for all coaches at this time. Coaches should review the competition outline from the registration packet prior to the meeting. Any final information and updates will be provided at the meeting.

Wednesday, April 20

Interview – 3–7 p.m. (Zoom link will be sent to coaches)

Interviews will be conducted in an online Zoom room. The Zoom link will be emailed to coaches prior to the competition. Students should log into the Zoom 10 minutes prior to their scheduled interview time. Students should be ready to present their competition ID and photo ID if requested to do so. A description of the online interview procedure will be made available on the 2022 USAD Nationals webpage.

Thursday, April 21

Speech – 3–7 p.m. (Zoom link will be sent to coaches)

All participants will present their speeches before a panel of two or three speech judges in an online Zoom room. The Zoom link will be emailed to coaches prior to the competition. Students should log into the Zoom 10 minutes prior to their scheduled speech time. Students should be ready to present their competition ID and photo ID if requested to do so. A description of the online speech procedure will be made available on the 2022 USAD Nationals webpage.

Friday, April 22

Objective testing – 12:45–4:55 p.m.

Varsity Super QuizTM - 5:00-5:10 p.m. Scholastic Super QuizTM - 5:15-5:25 p.m. Honor Super QuizTM - 5:30-5:40 p.m.

Super Quiz[™] - Each student will be provided with a Super Quiz test key based on their GPA category. All varsity students will have the same 18-question varsity Super Quiz test key, all scholastic students will have the same 18-question scholastic Super Quiz test key, and all honor students will have the same 18-question honor Super Quiz test key. The questions and subjects are randomized with the exception of the two mathematics questions, which will be the final two questions on each Super Quiz test. Students will have 10 minutes to complete the Super Quiz test.

Saturday, April 23

• Awards announcements 12–3 p.m.

Subject area awards, team awards, memorial awards, and scholarships will be announced online. All awards will be mailed to recipients following the competition.

Score results

Scores will NOT be posted during the competition. Coaches and state directors will be emailed a copy of their results.

Champions reception – 3:30–4:30 p.m. (Zoom link will be sent to coaches)

The top three U.S. teams (coaches, students, and state directors) in each division will gather for a virtual celebration following the awards ceremony.

Miscellaneous Information

April postings

Team ID numbers will be assigned and posted on the 2022 USAD Nationals webpage in early April after all state competitions have been completed. The interview and speech schedule will also be posted at that time.

Decathlete behavior

The failure of any member of the team to adhere to the policies and procedures listed in the USAD Code of Conduct may result in the disqualification of the delinquent decathlete and/or the entire team.
