In this U.S. Academic Decathlon Program Brochure, you will find the essential resources your team will need to participate and compete successfully in the U.S. Academic Decathlon.

Please take note of the following information from this year's U.S. Academic Decathlon[®] Study Guide.

Essential Information for Coaches

- The United States Academic Decathlon competition is comprised of ten events. There are seven multiplechoice exams—one in each of the following subject areas: art, economics, literature, mathematics, music, science, and social science. Students will also take an essay exam and will be judged in a speech event as well as an interview event.
- The culmination of the competition is the Super QuizTM relay. The Super Quiz relay includes questions (in multiple-choice format) from the following seven subject areas: art, economics, literature, mathematics, music, science, and social science.
- For all Academic Decathlon competitions prior to Nationals, the multiple-choice exams in art, economics, literature, music, science, and social science each have 50 questions. The mathematics exam has 35 questions. Coaches can contact their State Director to find out the format that will be used for the Super Quiz relay.
- At the 2024 Nationals, the number of questions per test may differ from the number of questions per test at regional and state competitions. The U.S. Academic Decathlon will inform teams of the number of test items in each subject at Nationals prior to the event.
- For all Academic Decathlon competitions prior to Nationals, students will be given 30 minutes to complete each of the written multiple-choice exams. Students will have 50 minutes to complete the essay exam.

- The United States Academic Decathlon permits students to use calculators, including graphing calculators, for the mathematics exam only, provided they have none of the features listed in Section III of the USAD Calculator Policy. Coaches can view this calculator policy on the USAD website <<u>https://</u><u>www.usad.org/Coaches/AD-Calculator-Policy.aspx</u>> or contact USAD to receive a copy of the calculator policy.
- The literature test items will be derived from the selected works of literature and from the information provided in the *Literature Resource Guide*. The literature test will include a critical reading passage with accompanying test items. The literature test will also expect students to be able to analyze the selected works of literature as well as the critical reading passage and will expect students to be familiar with literary terms and devices.
- The United States Academic Decathlon competition tests will be written in accordance with the topics and percentages noted in the subject area outlines that are published in the Academic Decathlon Study Guide.
- The United States Academic Decathlon offers Resource Guides and Student Exercise Books in art, economics, literature, mathematics, music, science, and social science. The Resource Guides and Student Exercise Books will assist students in their study of the topics listed in the subject area outlines. All USAD competition test items will be derived from the information and concepts presented in the

Resource Guides as well as the selected literature, artworks, and musical works.

- The 2023–24 mathematics curriculum and materials (including the subject area outline, Resource Guide, Student Exercise Book, and Notebook Divider) will be the same as were used for the 2020–21 United States Academic Decathlon.
- All curriculum and practice test materials, except for the Notebook Dividers and the Flashcards, are available in digital format ONLY. The Notebook Dividers are available in print format only, and the Flashcards are offered in both digital and print format.
- USAD is no longer offering a music CD or mp3 for purchase. Instead, the titles (and composers and/or featured artists where applicable) of the fourteen selected musical works will be shared with participants.

- While the *Art Resource Guide* includes information relevant to the eighteen selected artworks, this guide contains text only and does NOT include images of the artworks.
- The *Art Reproductions Booklet* contains reproductions of the eighteen artworks that are included in this year's art outline. However, please be aware that no text beyond the title, artist, date, etc., accompanies these artworks.
- Test writers have been instructed to construct tests such that at least 10–20% of the questions on each test require the use of higher-order thinking skills.
- All USAD materials are copyrighted. USAD materials may not be duplicated or posted to any public or private sites on the Internet for any reason without written permission from USAD. Violators may be prosecuted.

THE ONLINE MARKET:



OVERVIEW

- United States Academic Pentathlon is the newest program from the United States Academic Decathlon[®]. This premier national scholastic competition for middle school students was created to provide opportunities for students to experience the challenges of rigorous team and individual competition.
- The five-event academic program strives to foster a greater respect for knowledge, to promote wholesome inter-school academic competition, and to further develop student communication skills.
- Academic Pentathlon is uniquely designed to include students with a wide variety of academic abilities.

GETTING STARTED

- Academic Pentathlon teams should consist of a maximum of nine team members and a minimum of six team members. All students must be currently enrolled in grades 6–8. Each team must consist of at least two "A" students, at least two "B" students, and at least two "C or below" students. The team score will be determined by the sum of the top two student scores in each GPA category. The GPA Calculation Form can be found on the <u>USAP web page</u>.
 - Teams advance through local, regional, and state levels of competition. The state champions compete in the national finals. MOST Academic Pentathlon competitions take place online in a virtual testing environment, so there is no travel required for teams! The National Academic Pentathlon competition is held in a physical location.
 - Academic Pentathlon teams are encouraged to partner with local high school Academic Decathlon teams, perhaps having Academic Decathlon students serve as mentors to Pentathlon students.

CURRICULUM

- Academic Pentathlon's curriculum is an interdisciplinary curriculum in which a selected theme is integrated across five different subject areas: fine arts, literature, mathematics, science, and social science.
- The Academic Pentathlon theme parallels that of the high school Academic Decathlon program.
- The theme for the 2023-2024 is Technology and Humanity. The themes are developed by our curriculum team with special attention to national content standards.
- The materials will be available for downloading in PDF format on August 1st each year. The site license fee allows you to download as many copies as needed. Novels may be purchased via online vendors such as Amazon or via your regular school vendors. The 2023–2024 novel is *Cinder* by Marissa Meyer, ISBN-10: 1250768888.
 - All test questions will be derived from the USAP curriculum.
